Praying for a miracle— a miracle so ordinary that we as a nation generally take for granted—the simple provision of food, education and accommodation. Yet today many desperately needy children in Uganda are praying for such a miracle.

As Christians we have the greatest message in world but the hungry, the poor, the homeless and the fatherless need more than words. They need to experience the tangible evidence of God's love through lives filled with the compassion of Jesus: compassion that burdens hearts to practically help these children.

I am sure that there are many who want to help but don't know how. This is where Life Line Child Sponsorship opens the door for your personal involvement and financial support. The Agape School in Busembatia Uganda. offers boarding and a Christian education to 'poor and very poor' children. The initial intake was 300 and now it has risen to 900. There are many who need help. Can you, prompted by God's love, answer just one of their prayers for a 'miracle'?



Keep it personal!

When you sponsor a child with Lifeline you will receive a photograph and details of your child. You will also receive periodic updates from the school so you can learn how your child is getting on.

Keep it simple!

How often do you get the chance to directly improve the life of not just one child but also the lives of their family, friends and neighbours? Sponsorship can be taken out from as little as £15 a month and can help to provide board, room and school fees.

To sponsor a primary child this will cost £55 per term and a secondary pupil will cost £65 in fees per term but if you can not afford this out going you can pledge any amount from £5 a month. This will help these children to provide food, bedding, books etc. All money received will be directed to the children and you will receive a certificate stating exactly what affect your contribution had in their lives

Your sponsorship can make the world of difference to a child who will become part of your life.

Lifeline Ministries work closely with other churches and organisations to help these children plan for a better future.

If child sponsorship is too large a financial commitment you can contribute in other ways. There are many different projects you can get involved with.

An example of the above is the Chicken book. This is a project designed to enable the Ugandan children and adults to become more self sufficient. The project gives the West a chance to buy livestock or land in order that people can generate provision and economic growth. (£20 foot of land £2/ Chicken, £5 / piglet or goat)
